



- Self-Assessment for basic learning (A1 questions: clinical scenario/MCQs with 2 to 5 Marks)
- <u>2. Intermediate Knowledge</u> [what all postgraduate trainees should know]
- Intermediate Learning text
- Self-Assessment for intermediate learning (A1 questions: clinical scenario/MCQs with 2 to 5 Marks)

<u>3. Advanced Knowledge</u> [what all postgraduate residents should know] can be presented as **podcast**, **video**, **audio**, **powerpoint**, **interview**..

- Advance learning from the main text + IDD1- IDD2
- Self Assessment for Advance learning (A1 questions: clinical scenario/MCQs with 2 to 5 Marks)

<u>4. Applied Learning [covering basic and intermediate mainly but also advanced learning]</u>
