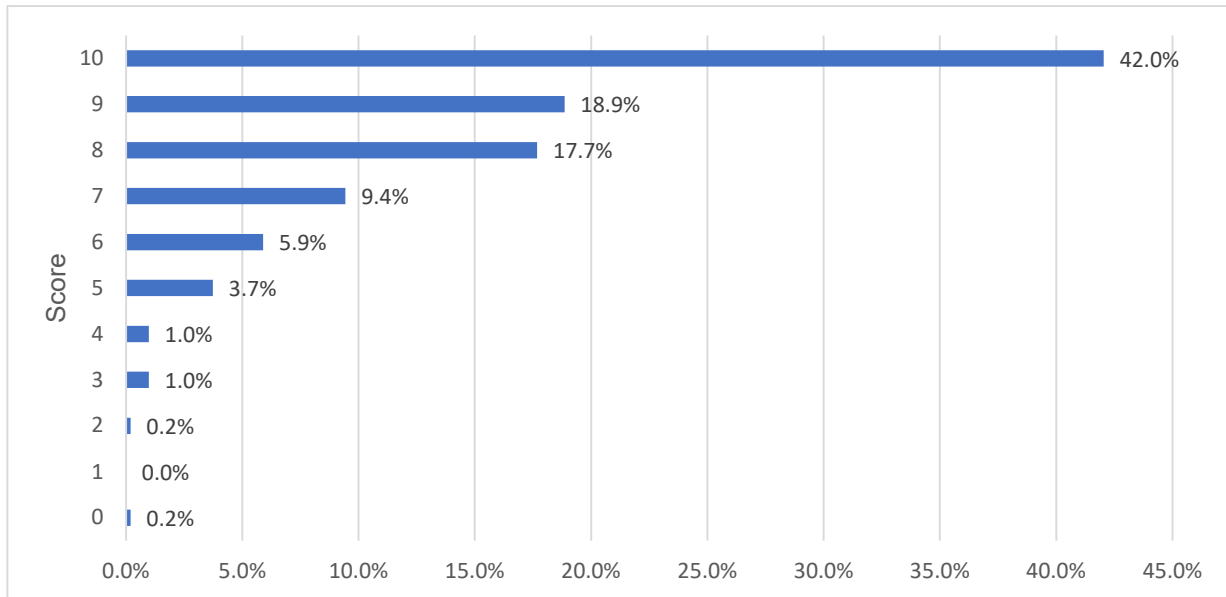

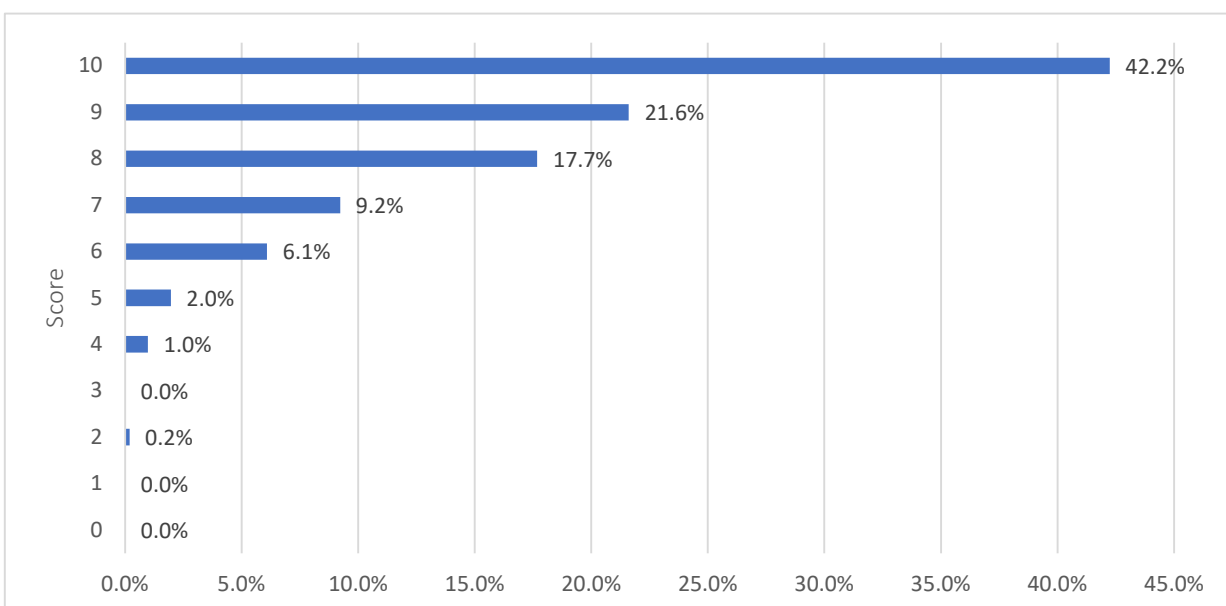

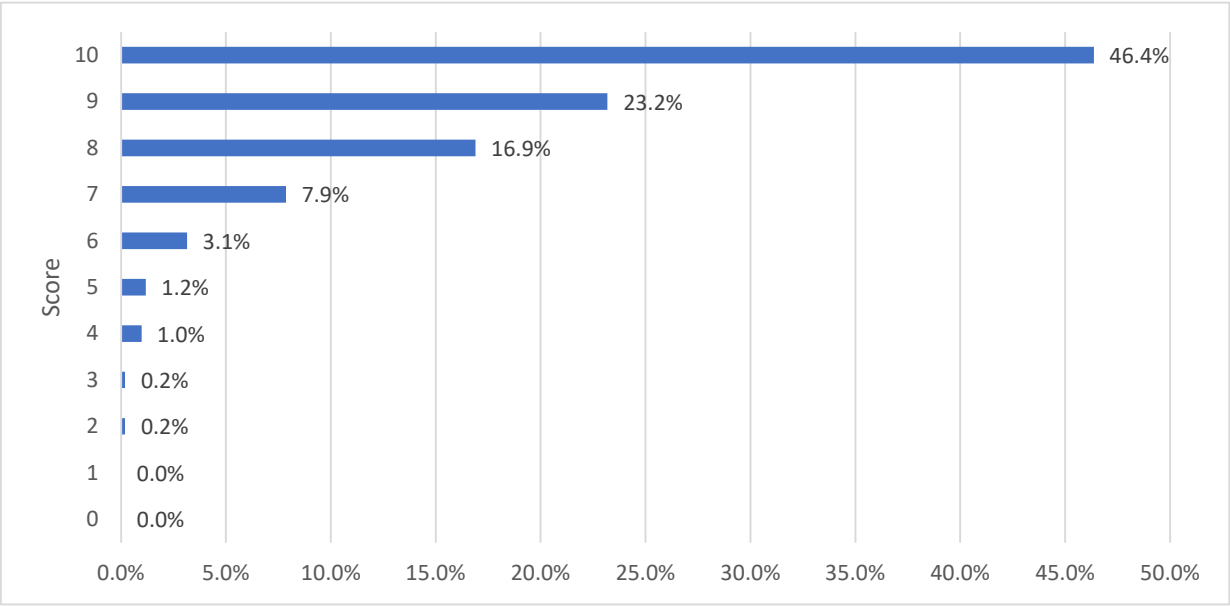

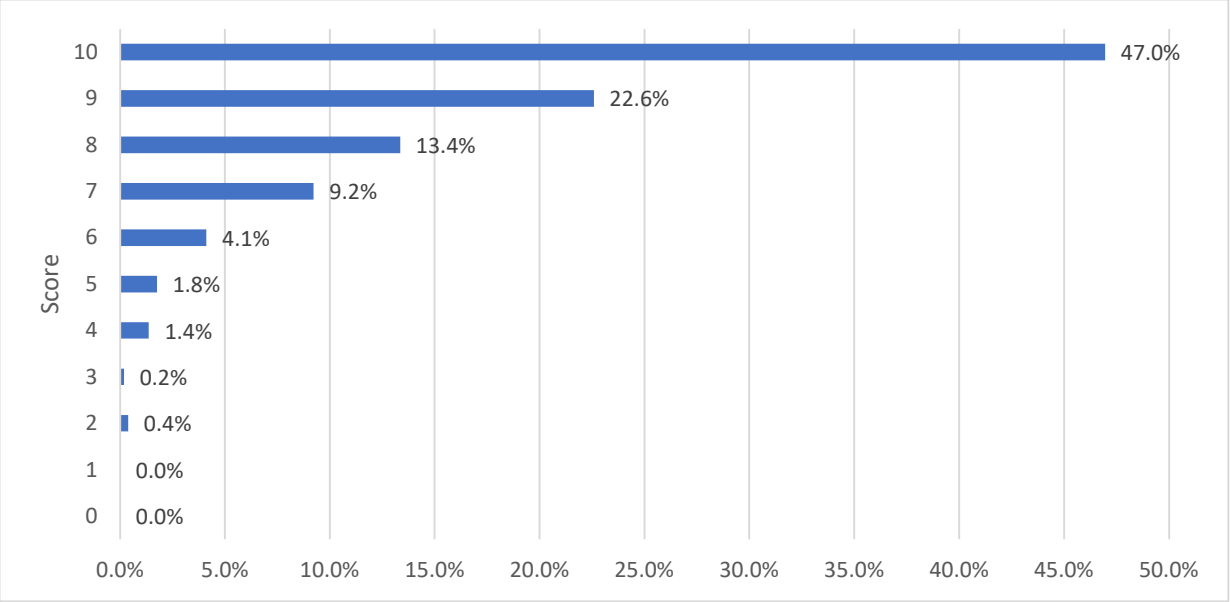

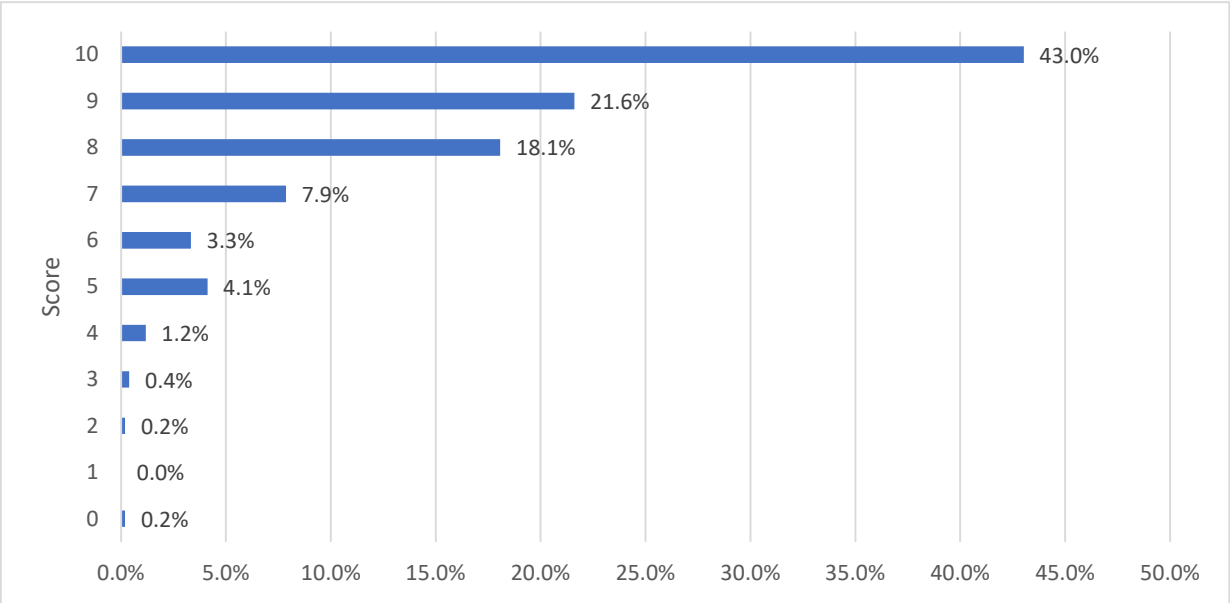

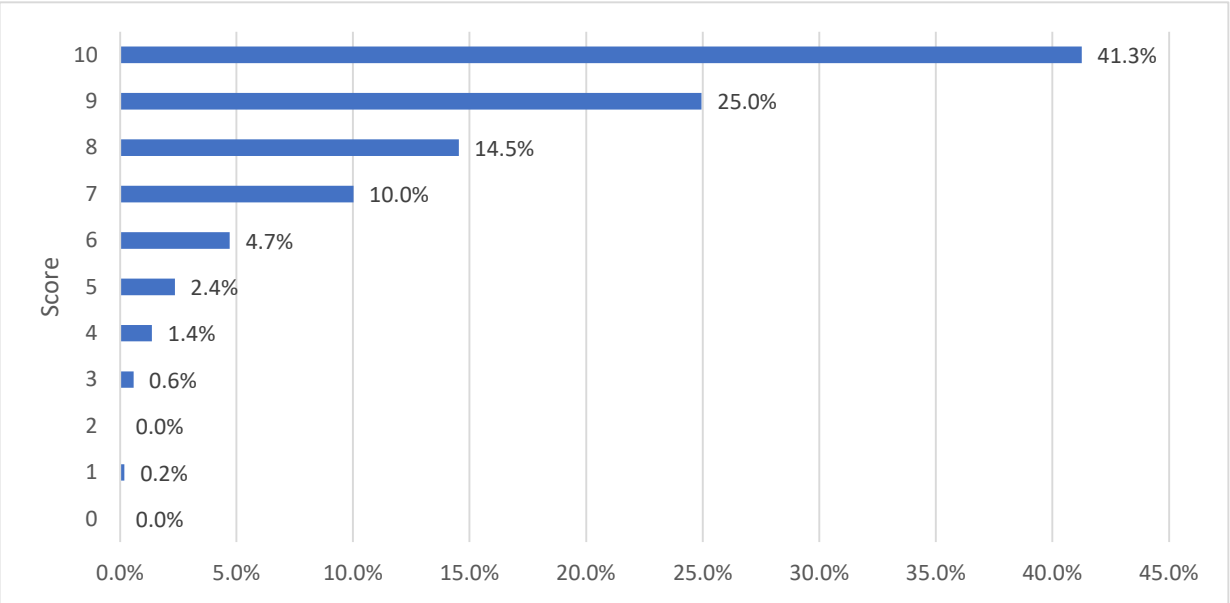

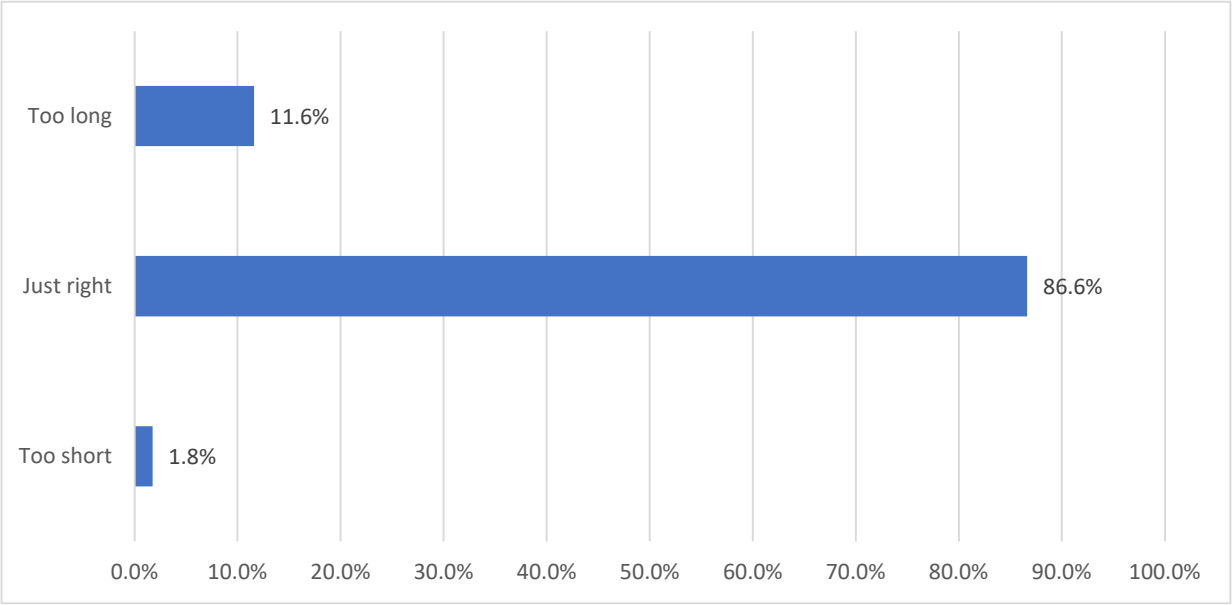

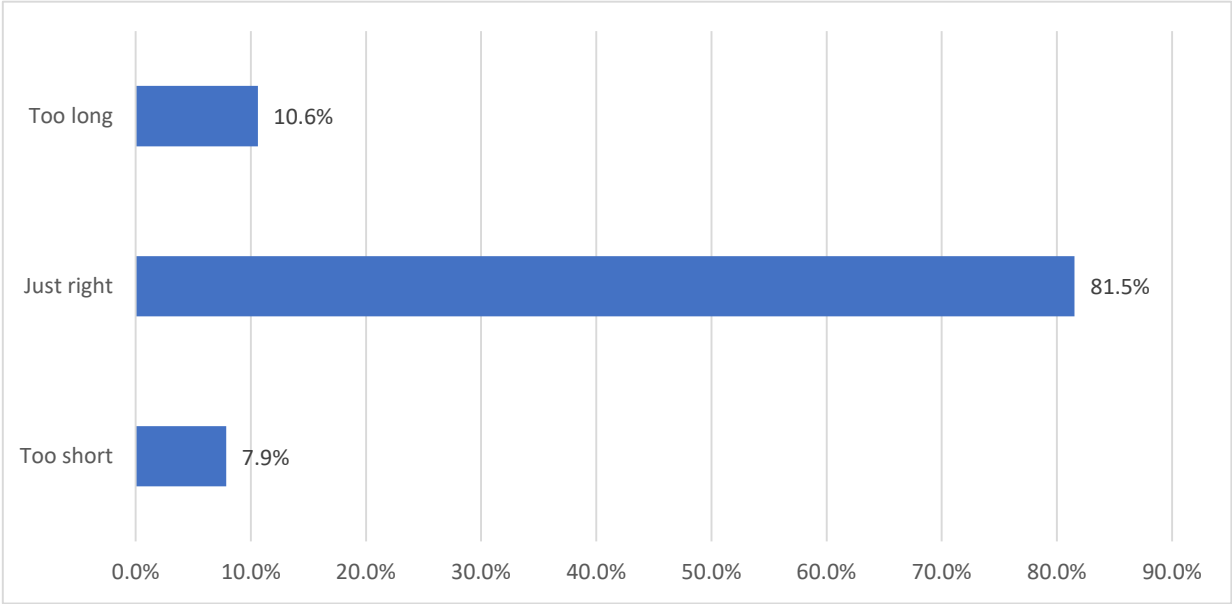

The language of self assessment quiz was confusing in most places, one small e.g, it asked for symptoms in one of the questions and since lab investigations and histological findings are not considered as symptoms but rather signs, it marked the answer incorrectly which is little frustrating and brought down the total scores. 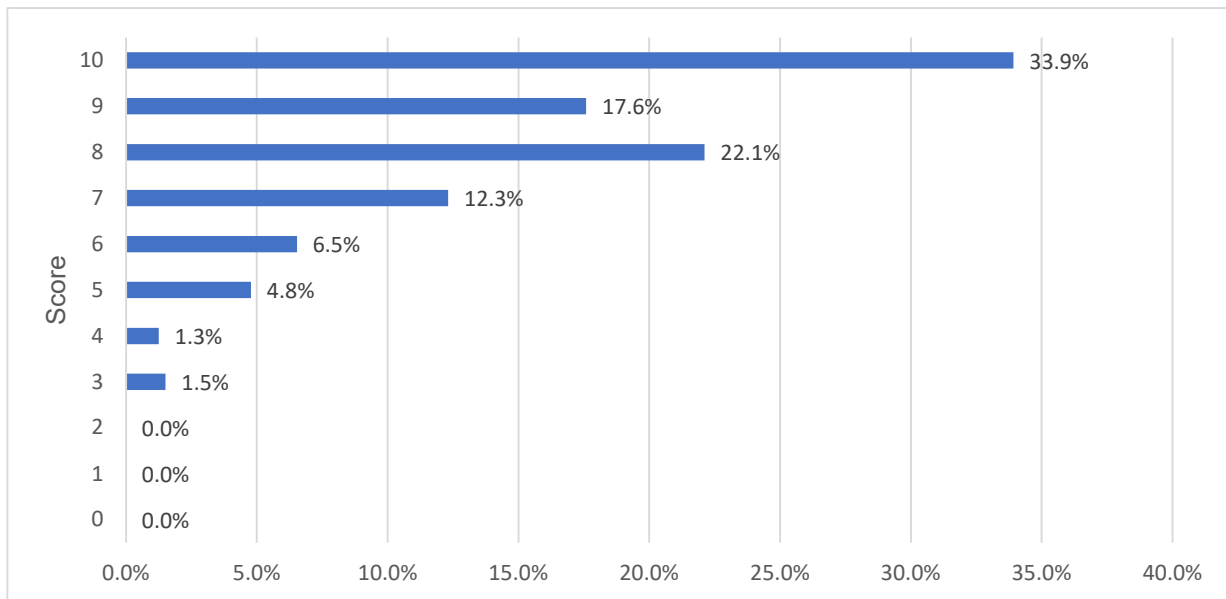

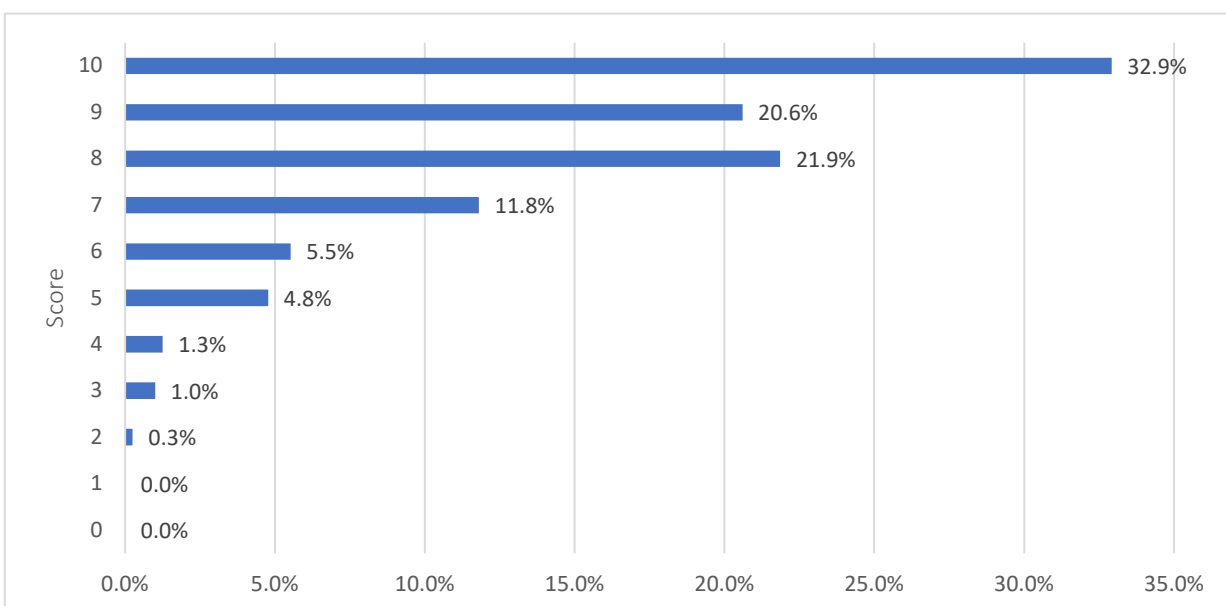

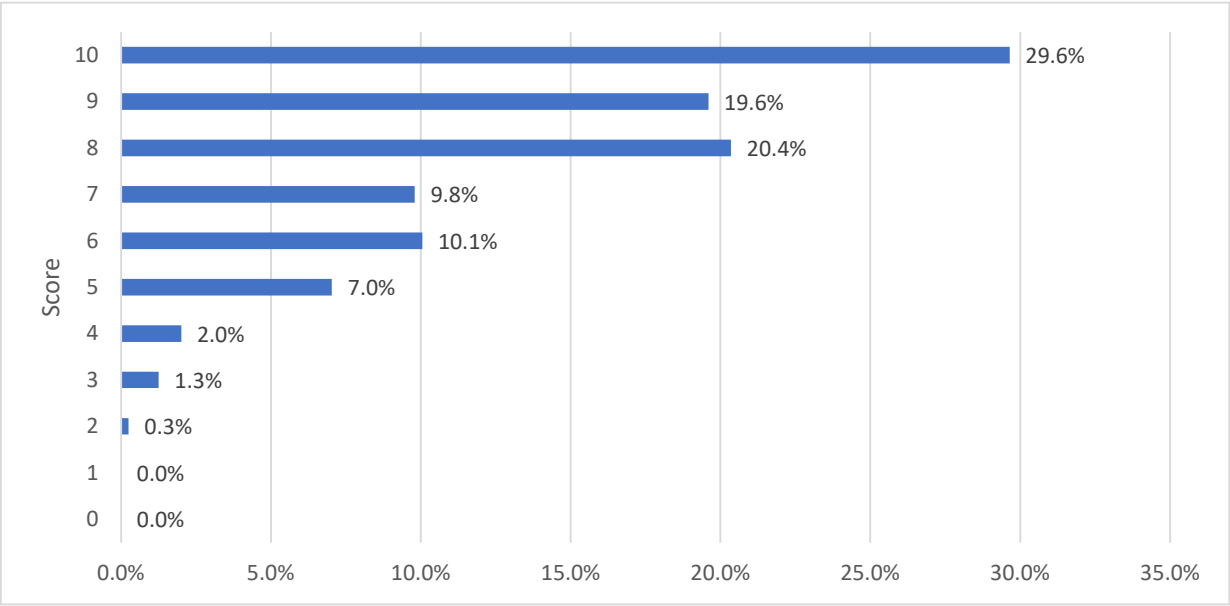

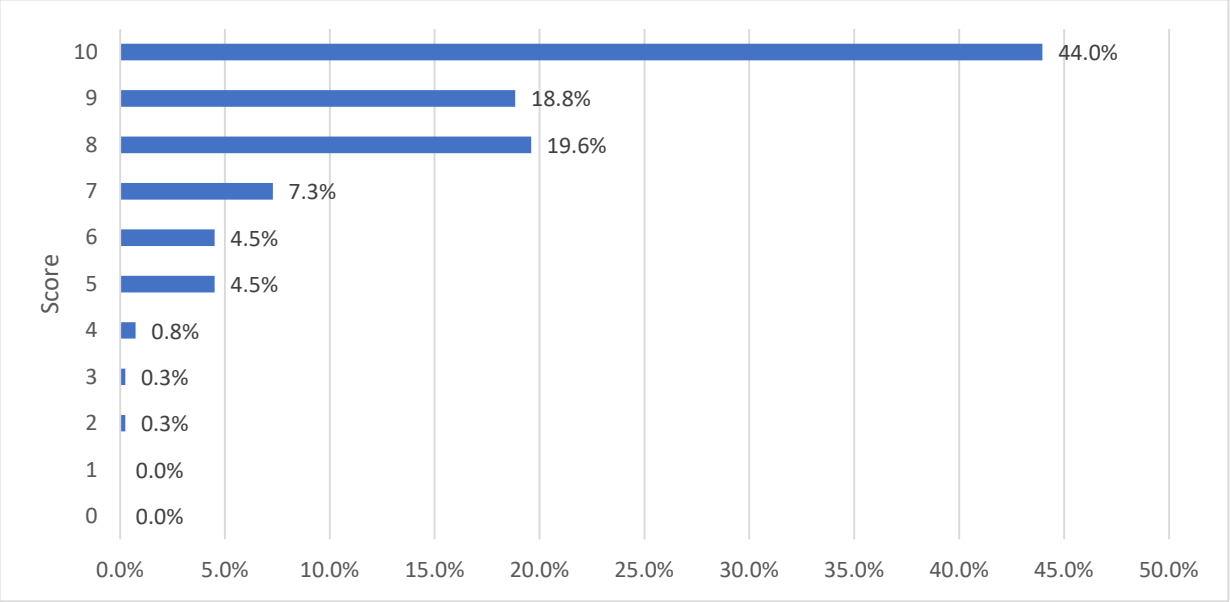

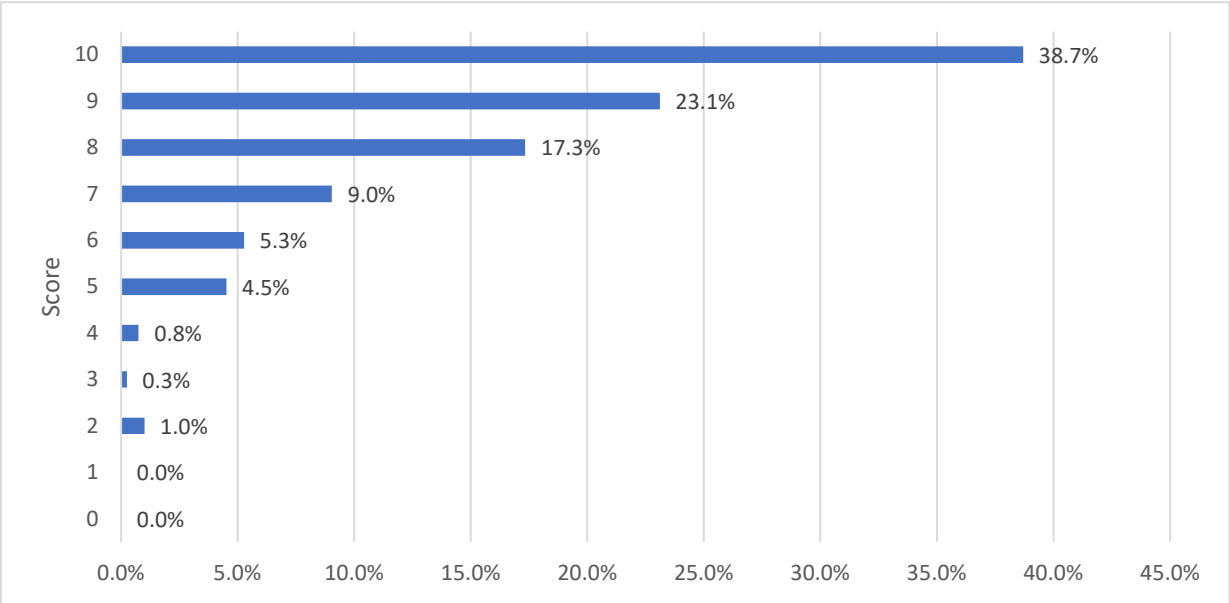

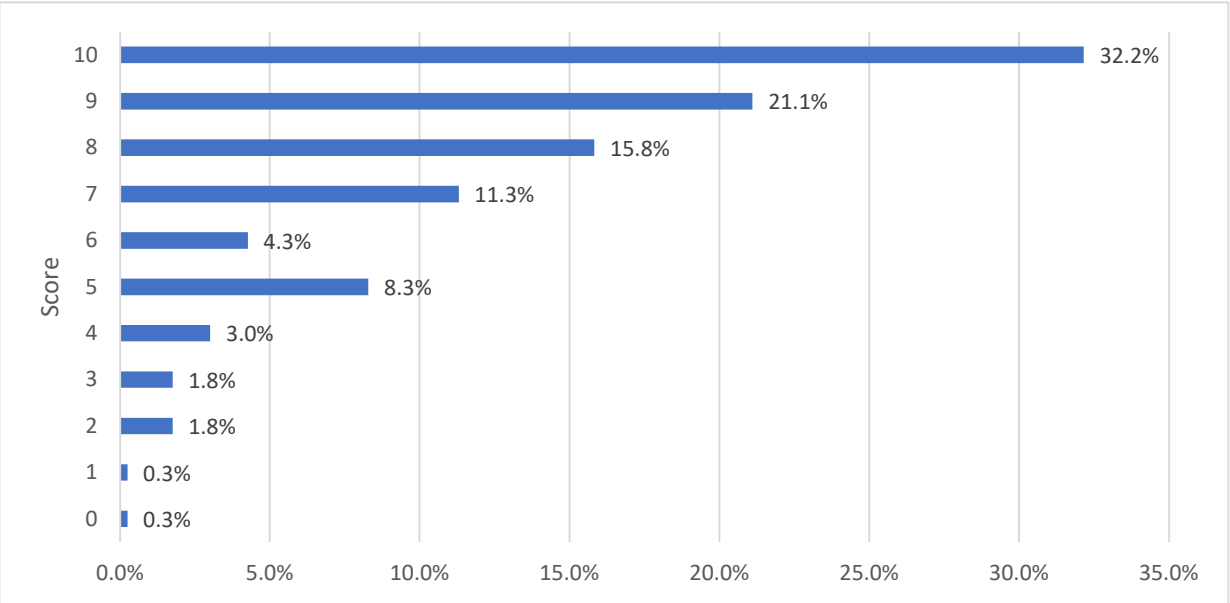

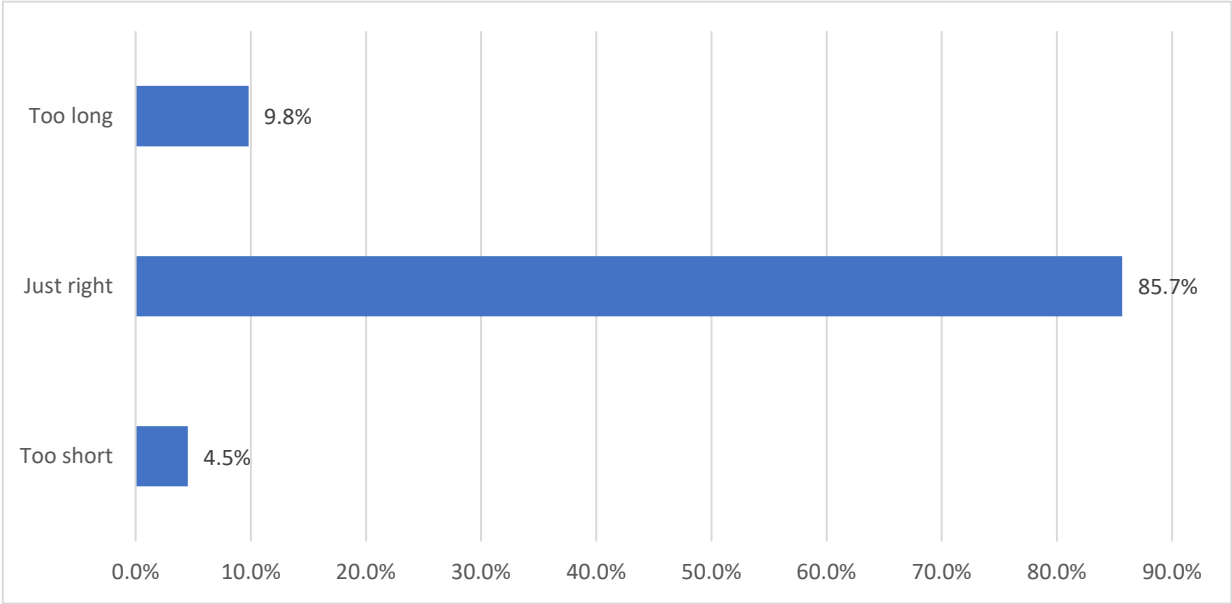

I found it infuriating to be marked "incorrect" in labelling a certain joint (eg PIPs) lower or higher than another. In practice, you see the entire patient and don't concern yourself with grading the joints in order of importance - every single joint, every single piece of history and the entirety of the patient presentation will point you in the direction of a diagnosis and being made to re-attempt this exercise 3 times until arriving at what another clinician deems best is ridiculous to me.
Wouldn't painful bony swelling over the PIPs be extremely important in pointing to the presence of OA? So, although I acknowledge their "lesser importance" in the diagnosis of RA - of course, their presence is invaluable in assessing whether OA coexists in the patient.
I was discontented and very frustrated by the end of this case which asks you to rate joints more than once.

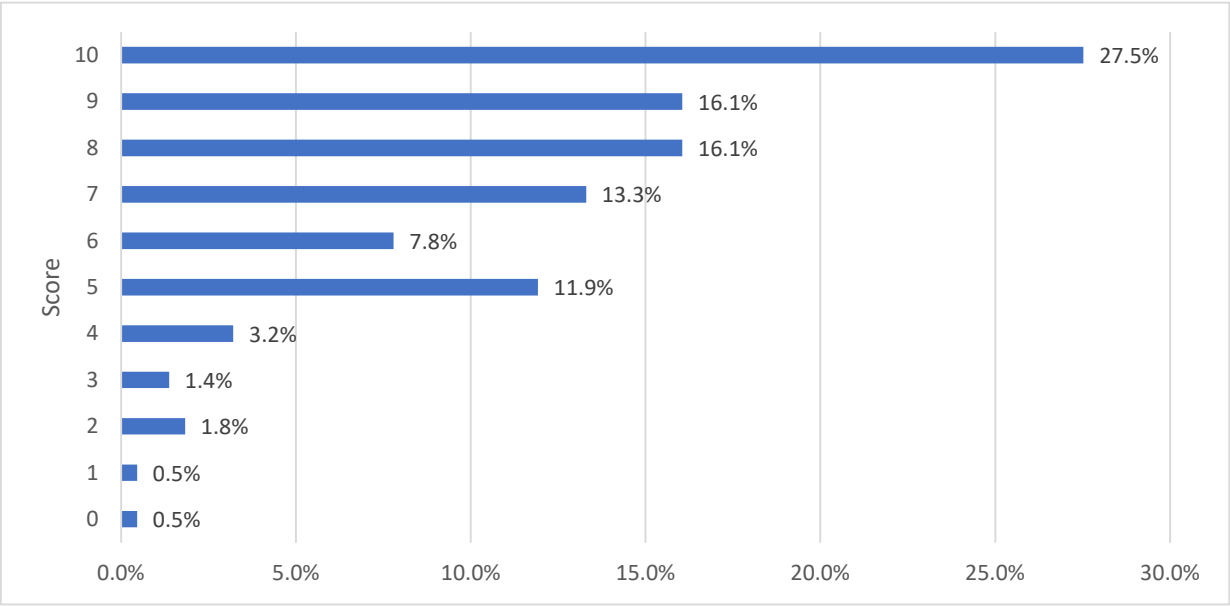

If this was incorrect, it implies we should be encouraging patients to smoke! There are some typographical mistakes through the module. It would be helpful if, in the answers to the knowledge test, there was an explanation of the x-ray findings, perhaps with joint fluid on the x-ray being annotated.
The first in depth discussion linked to an in depth discussion on NOD like receptors instead of the management of acute anterior uveitis. The second interactive case was worded poorly - for example one of the questions asked what you would want to do next management wise and giving antibiotics was considered an incorrect answer (when patient had just tested positive for chlamydia) but when you expanded the answer sections afterwards it said that you would also give antibiotics for the chlamydia infection - therefore maybe the question could be better worded as what would you do next to manage the arthritis? The last question of the case also asked for 2 correct answers but when you tried to put in two answers it turned out there were actually 3 correct answers. One of the questions in the quiz was outdated as Secukinumab is now licensed (in the UK anyway) for nrAxSpA A lot of the 'back to course buttons' don't work

There was a great deal of overt Western arrogance overriding this section and it made me feel sick to read it.</p> <p>In a few graphs we were shown the figures of the MSK burden of disease in other countries (so called developing countries) and it was clear that it was a minimal problem in these countries.
