COURSE DESCRIPTION

This is a 1.5-day course for health professionals in rheumatology (HPR) on the **basic** management of common rheumatic and musculoskeletal conditions (RMDs), taught by selected faculty of European experts in a very interactive and cordial environment. The course will focus on knowledge and skills most relevant for HPRs' daily practice. Participants have the opportunity to meet experts in an informal setting and network with other HPR with different professional backgrounds and career pathways.

Learning objectives

- Obtain up to date knowledge on the epidemiology, pathogenesis, diagnosis and management of common RMDs, in particular RA and OA
- Be familiar with interventions commonly executed by health professionals in rheumatology (HPR) in the treatment of patients with RMDs
- Have in-depth knowledge on psychosocial aspects of RMDs and behavioral change techniques.
- Apply the principles of evidence-based practice and continuous professional development to one's own practice

Course certification

100% course attendance is required, to receive the 4th EULAR Postgraduate Course Health Professionals in Rheumatology certificate after the course.

The course will integrate with the EULAR Educational Programme / EULAR School of Rheumatology and objectives.
